WHAT IS INDOOR AIR QUALITY?

Indoor air quality refers to the characteristics of the indoor climate of a building with special concern for the impact on people's health.

HOW DOES FURNITURE IMPACT INDOOR AIR QUALITY?

When furnishings are installed in the workplace, they might release VOCs (volatile organic compounds) from materials or finishes thus negatively impacting the quality of the air inside the building.

WHAT IS THE SCS INDOOR ADVANTAGE™ GOLD LABEL?

The Indoor Advantage™ Gold label is awarded by third party certifier Scientific Certification Systems. It is awarded by SCS to products that do not exceed the VOC emission criteria established in the BIFMA X7.1 Emission Standard and/or meet the more stringent California Section 01350 criteria adopted by Collaborative for High Performance Schools (CHPS). The Indoor Advantage Gold mark also contributes to LEED rating systems. It is comparable to the GreenGuard® Children and Schools label.

WHAT IS INTEGRACLEAR™?

IntegraClear™ is National's proprietary, water-based finish cured via ultraviolet (UV) light and offers exceptional clarity and durability in our wood products. This environmentally-friendly finish helps our products meet or exceed indoor air quality requirements.

WHAT IS CARB?

California Air Resources Board (CARB) regulatory code 93120 established limits on the emissions of formaldehyde from core materials and finished goods being sold for use in the state of California. National products satisfy CARB phase 1 and 2 requirements.
